### **Recommended Entrances**

To make your entry to the circuit easier, we recommend the following gates based on your grandstand location:

- **Gate A/B – Vedano**  
Grandstands: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, GF
- **Gate B – Santa Maria**  
Grandstands: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 15, 16, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, General Admission
- **Gate C – Costa Bassa**  
Grandstands: 6, 7, 8, 12, 15, 16, General Admission
- **Gate D – Lesmo**  
Grandstands: 6, 9, 10, 10Bis, 11, 12, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, General Admission
- **Gate G – Mirabello**  
Grandstands: 9, 10, 10Bis, 11, 12, 15, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, GF, General Admission

### **Available Parking:**

Find the closest parking to your entrance:

- **Green Parking:** 500 m from Gates C and D (motorcycles and campers included) | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **Gold Parking:** 1 km from Gate A and 1.5 km from Gate G (motorcycles included) | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **Orange Parking:** 2 km from Gate A (closes at 22:30, motorcycles included) | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **Platinum Parking:** 1 km from Gate A | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **White Parking:** 600 m from Gate C | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **Red Parking:** 3.5 km from Gate G (buses included) | **FRI-SAT-SUN**
- **Brown Parking:** 1 km from Gates C and B (buses included) | **SAT-SUN**
- **Purple Parking:** Use the Purple Shuttle to reach Gate A | **SAT-SUN**
- **Blue Parking:** Use the Blue Shuttle to reach Gate G | **SAT-SUN**

## Special Trains

To make your journey easier, Trenitalia and Trenord are offering special connections:

### Trenitalia:

**EuroCity (EC):** 8 direct connections to Zurich and 9 from Zurich. Travel to Milan with Frecciarossa, Intercity, or regional trains, and then continue with Trenord regional services.

## Trenord

**Milan – Biassono-Lesmo:** 21 special trains from Milan Porta Garibaldi to Biassono-Lesmo, only on Sunday, September 1 (until seats are sold out)

**Milan – Monza (Train + Shuttle):** Return train from Milan to Monza FS and Black Shuttle from Monza FS to the Circuit (Gate G), available all three days. Ticket also valid on trains Milan Centrale/Monza and Trenitalia ECs only on September 1. Not valid on special trains Milan Porta Garibaldi/Biassono-Lesmo.

**Day Pass Trenord 2024:** Return from anywhere in Lombardy to Monza FS or Biassono-Lesmo, valid for all three days. Kids under 14 travel free with an adult.

Regional Trenord services (2nd class STIBM) between Milan and Monza are available through the Trenitalia APP or on the Trenord website.

## Prohibited Items

To ensure everyone's safety, the following items are not allowed in the circuit:



### SONO AMMESSI:



- Bottiglie e borracce di plastica/metallo fino a 500 ml con tappo;
- Ombrelli per pioggia senza punta metallica;
- Macchine fotografiche treppiedi, monopiedi e bastoni per selfie;
- Aste flessibili di plastica per bandiere;
- Computer portatili e altri apparecchi elettronici (tablet, e-reader, Power Bank di piccole dimensioni max 300g) all'ingresso gli addetti al controllo chiederanno di accendere l'apparecchio e mostrarne il funzionamento;
- Accendini tascabili;
- Sedie e Sgabelli pieghevoli (no legno).

### ALLOWED:



- Plastic/metal bottles and canteens until 500 ml with caps;
- Rain umbrellas without metallic extremity;
- Photo Cameras, Tripods, monopods and selfie sticks;
- Flexible plastic flag rods;
- Laptops or other electronic devices (tablet, e-reader, little dimensions power banks max 300g). At the entrance the control staff will ask you to switch on the device and show if it works;
- Pocket lighters;
- Chairs and folding stools (no wood).
